Dollar Amount: \$5-20,000

Requirements: Critical financial need, minimum 2.0 gpa, involvement in extra-curricular and community service activities, strong commitment to pursue a bachelor's degree. Apply online www.horatioalger.org/scholarships

Coca-Cola Scholars Foundation – apply online

Due Date: October 31

Dollar Amount: Fifty \$20,000 awards, 200 \$4,000 awards

Requirements: All US high school seniors, preferably with a 3.0 grade point average or above. www.coca-colascholars.org

Due Date: December 1

Dollar Amount: \$5,500 last year, up to 4 year renewal

Requirements: Given to a student who is attending the UofI only. This is need-based, but the student must also be of good character, and have shown an interest in family, community, and national affairs. Must write a 500-word essay on what they would do if they won this award and how this award will help them achieve their goal. **NO COVER SHEET. See Mrs. Morris if you're interested. Must be fully admitted to the U of I by their priority application deadline (Dec 1) or you cannot be considered.**

Due Date: December 2

Dollar Amount: 500 - \$1,000

Requirements: Need, leadership and scholarship. www.elks.org/enf/scholars

National Wild Turkey Federation – apply online

Due Date: December 14

Dollar Amount: \$500 for local winners, \$1,000 for a state winner

Requirements: Graduating senior with a 3.0 gpa. Must have proof of current hunting license, membership in the WTF, three letters of recommendation, involved in school, leadership and community activities, essay. www.nwtf.org, outreach, xtreme jakes, xtreme scholarships

Due Date: January 11

Dollar Amount: \$1,000

Requirements: Must be US citizen, resident of Idaho and continuing your education at an accredited post-secondary college, university, or vocational school. www.usjcisenate.org

Pride Foundation

Due Date: October through January

Dollar Amount: \$300,000 available to residents of Washington, Montana, Idaho, Oregon, or Alaska

Requirements: Preference is given to students who are self-identified as lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, their families, or straight allies. Application, letters of recommendation and transcripts. Apply online at www.pridefoundation.org

Elks Legacy Award – apply online

Due Date: January 31

Dollar Amount: 500 - \$1,000

Requirements: Must be a child or grandchild of an Elks member in good standing for two years. Must have taken the ACT before December 31. www.elks.org/enf/scholars

Due Date: February 5

Dollar Amount: \$250 - \$500

Requirements: Must be a child or grandchild of a trustee of an Idaho public school who served for a minimum of three years.

Alva W. Blackerby Scholarship – use Local Scholarship Application

Due Date: February 14

Dollar Amount: \$500

Requirements: Applicant must be a male student at GHS. This scholarship will be awarded not only based on merit but also on personality traits of the boy, such as the following: honesty, loyalty, tolerance, dependability, sportsmanship, intelligence, leadership, ability to get along with others, physical and nervous energy, drive and vigor of body and mind, love of the outdoors, community interest, spirit of public service, and affection for people. Each applicant must type a double spaced 300 to 500 word essay addressing how they have demonstrated the above mentioned qualities.

Lions Club Scholarship – use Local Scholarship Application

Due Date: February 14

Dollar Amount: 2 - \$2,500 toward 4-year degree, and 1 - \$1,000 toward a 2-year degree

Requirements: Applicant must be a senior at GHS. Some preference is given to Lion's Club Members' children. Each applicant needs to list the scholarships they have applied for and any that have been awarded. Each applicant must list his or her grade point average.

Gwen Smith (Syringa General Hospital Auxiliary Scholarship) – use Local Scholarship Application

Due Date: February 14

Dollar Amount: 2- \$1,000

Requirements: Must be enrolling in courses directed at the medical field. Interested students should send a personal resume including previous school activities, community involvement and intended goals for future education including the name of the college to be attended.

James Graham Webb Memorial Scholarship – use Local Scholarship Application

Due Date: February 14

Dollar Amount: 2 - \$2,000, renewable

Requirements: Recipient must be a US citizen and have a cumulative grade point average of no less than 2.75. Applicant should have been in high school debate or oratory activities, music, student government, mock trial, theater, or journalism (either school paper or yearbook) activities. Recipient must be pursuing an education in study of communications or an associated major with emphasis on radio/television, or in the fields of speech, oratory, debate, music, theater, or law. Recipient must maintain a 2.75 grade point average in their four years at college. Applicants shall type a double spaced 300-word essay on the value of the field of communication and why he or she has chosen this field.

Tony Haener Memorial Scholarship

Due Date: February 14

Dollar Amount: Not less than \$500

Requirements: GHS graduate. Application, essay. Must have an interest in a vocational school and career.

Idaho County Orchestra/Gary Forsmann Memorial Music Scholarship

Due Date: February 14

Dollar Amount: \$500

Requirements: Applicant should be involved in college music program. Application and essay introducing yourself and outlining how music has impacted your life and your goals in furthering your education.

Gary Cash Memorial Scholarship – use Local Scholarship Application

Due Date: February 14

Dollar Amount: Interest based

Requirements: Applicant must be a US citizen and prospective GHS graduate. The applicant must have a cumulative grade point average of no less than 2.75. Must have been active in one or more sports and lettered in at least two (2) years. The scholarship should be based on athletic endeavors, desire, determination, and good sportsmanship rather than emphasis on athletic ability. Each applicant must type a double spaced 300-word essay on his or her athletic endeavors, desire, determination, and good sportsmanship.

Keeler-Martin Wrestling Scholarship – use Local Scholarship Application

Due Date: February 14

Dollar Amount: Interest based

Requirements: Must be a US citizen and participant in wrestling. Must have a minimum gpa of 2.0. Must attach a statement as complete as possible regarding financial need. Each applicant must attach a typed, double spaced, essay on their participation in wrestling including a list of all the semesters they were on the team and any awards received during that time. They must tell why they enjoy the sport, how the sport develops character, and if they wish to continue wrestling while in college.

Foster Morgan and Elizabeth Kantola Scholarship – use Local Scholarship Application

Due Date: February 14

Dollar Amount: Interest based

Requirements: Applicant must be a US citizen and have no less than a 3.5 cumulative grade point average. The applicant must have shown active involvement in community service and write a 300-word essay on the community service including whom, when and the reason why they were involved in this service.

Dollar Amount: \$250 (?)
