

BILL EIMERS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

ESTABLISHED: 2015 by past students, friends, and citizens of GRANGEVILLE who appreciated his lifetime commitment to the community.

PURPOSE: To establish a \$10,000 Scholarship in memory of Bill Eimers; Teacher, Coach, Principal, Friend, Mentor, and dedicated citizen who spent his life giving to the community of GRANGEVILLE.

USE: Scholarship will be disbursed to the college of choice (either two year or four year) \$2500 annually for use as tuition, fees, books, room & board over four consecutive years. Scholarship is renewable for four years, with a minimum requirement of a 2.5 GPA per semester.

1. Any graduation high school Senior who attended GHS for a minimum of three years and has a cumulative four year GPA of 2.5 or higher.
2. Shows participation in school extracurricular activities, sports, clubs, music or school groups.
3. Involvement in church, outside civic activities that require helping those in need, youth groups and the disadvantaged.
4. Financial need may be considered along with any other factors deemed relevant by the selection committee.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: Completed application must be submitted by 1 April (or next school day after) to the College and Career Counseling Center at GHS.

SELECTION: Will be made by the committee composed of three to five representatives of GHS; Grangeville Community Foundation and from the Grangeville Community.

Letters of recommendation are welcome from Church Priests and Ministers, Local Clubs or Organizations w/ adult members who have observed the applicant over their GHS time are welcome.
